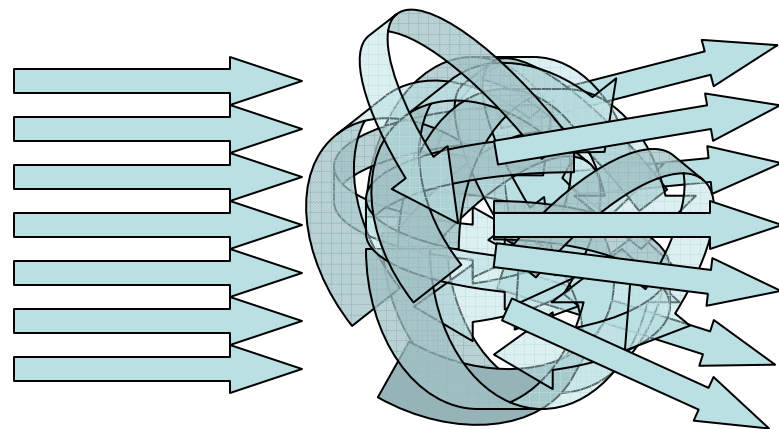

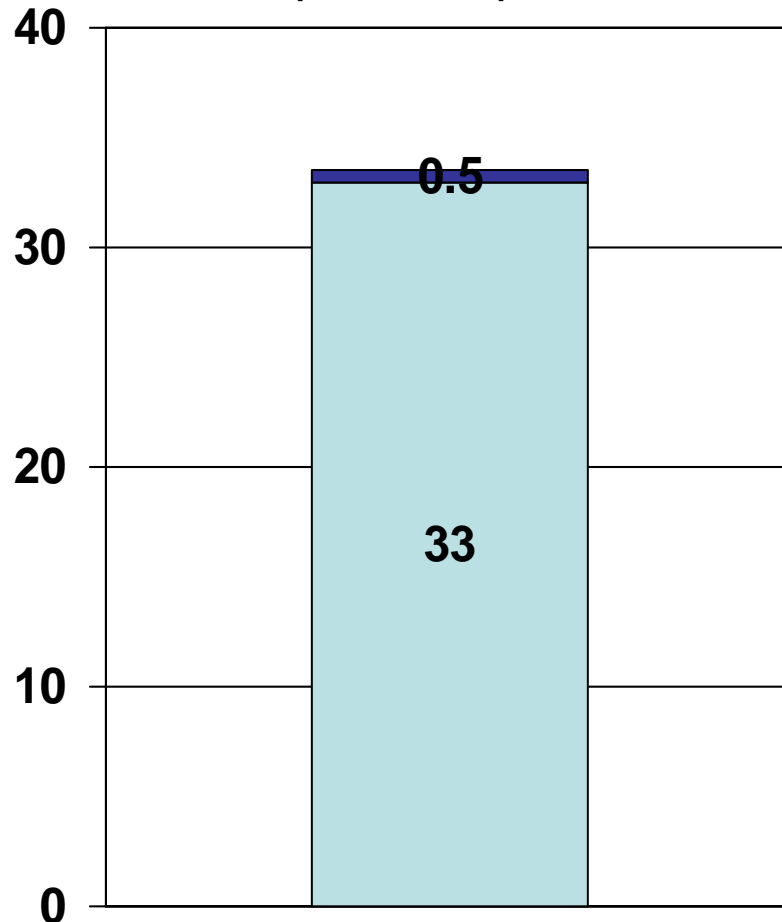

Estimated ARRA Funds
(In Billions)



- About \$500M to establish the HIE infrastructure necessary to achieve “meaningful use”
- \$33B in incentives to providers and hospitals
 - Providers - Up to \$44,000 each
 - Hospitals - \$2M - \$11M each

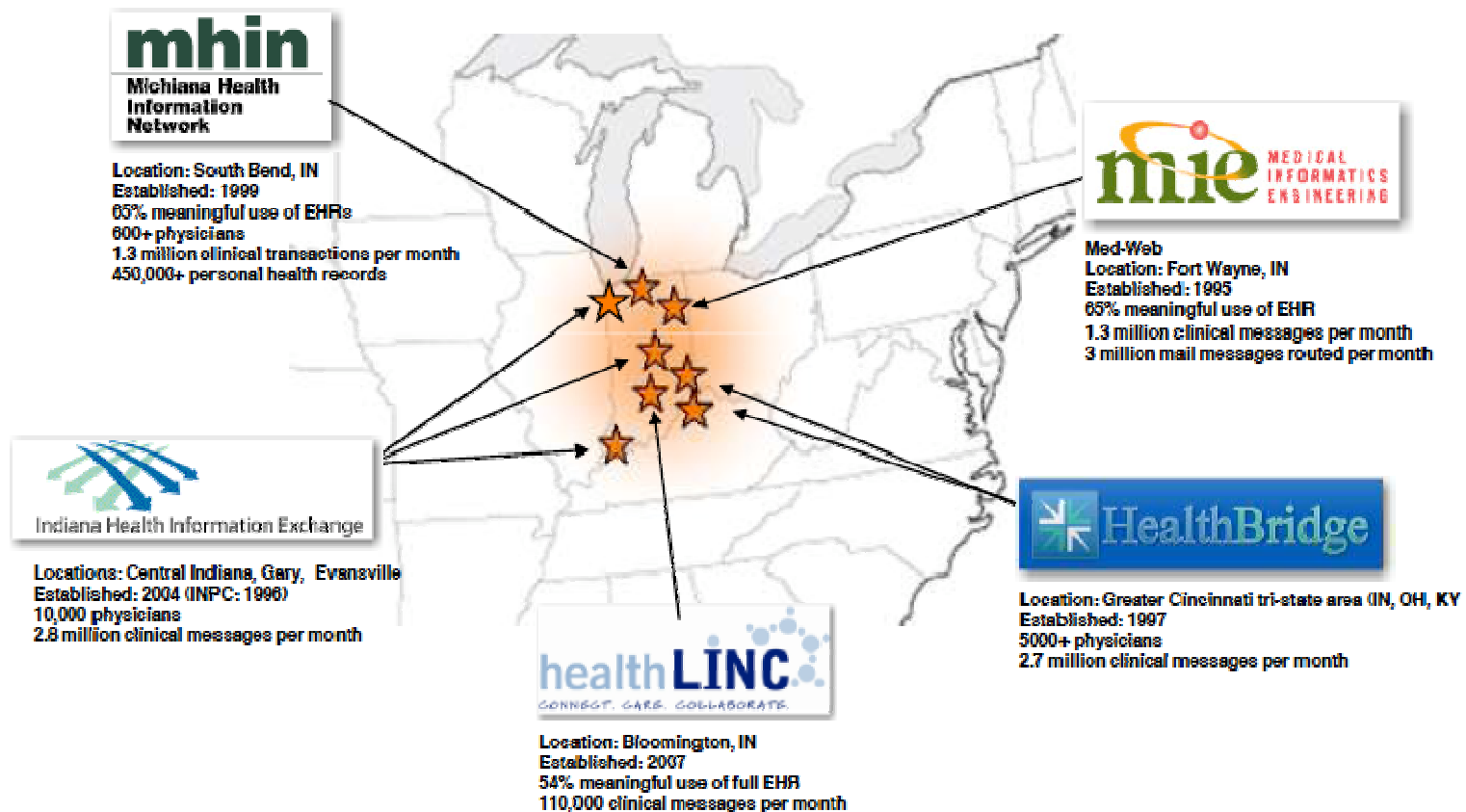
