



INDIANA DATABASE FOR UNIVERSITY RESEARCH EXPERTISE

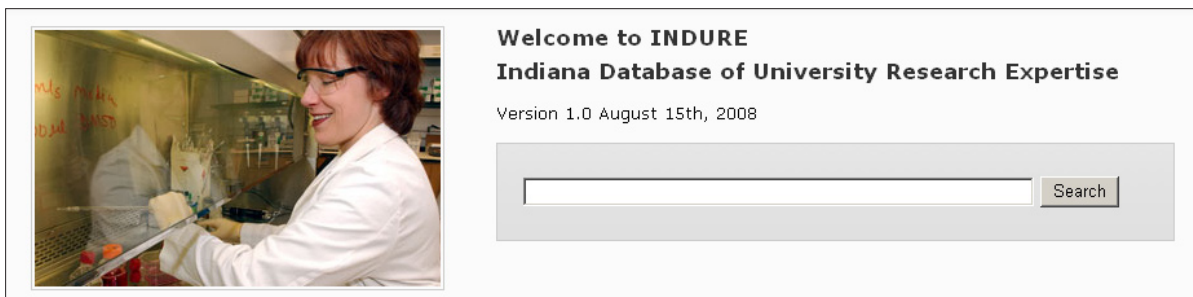
INDURE is an easy-to-access database of research expertise, intellectual property, and ongoing sponsored research projects at academic institutions across the state of Indiana.

Currently Ball State, Indiana University, Notre Dame and Purdue University are searchable. Phase 2 will include all Indiana academic institutions that elect to participate.

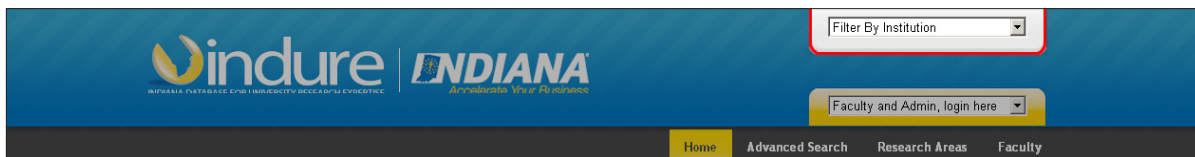
Simple to use.

1. Enter search term in window and click search.



2. To filter results by academic institution click the arrow in upper right corner of page.



3. Click on Faculty name and then on any underlined link of interest.

A complex algorithm ranks the faculty results by relevance to the search term(s). The larger the number the more relevant the search results.
