On December 4, 2009, the Indiana Health Industry Forum (IHIF) will host a Neuroscience Summit, fourth in a series of conferences examining sectors of critical importance to Indiana's health and life science industries.

This year's summit offers the opportunity to participate in a Poster Display in conjunction with the event. The Poster Display is open to companies, programs, initiatives, and products highlighting neurologic research, treatment, diagnostics, imaging, care delivery, and awareness programs.

Instructions for Poster Presenters:

- All presentations will be in poster form and displayed in a specific area of University Place Conference Center.
- The space available for each poster is 4 ft wide x 4 ft high.
- Limit of 30 posters. Applications accepted on a first-come, first-served basis.
- All posters will be mounted on the poster boards using pins. Pins will be provided.
- Please include a title for the poster and contact information for the presenter.
- Poster must be hung before 8:00 am on December 4.
- Posters will be available for viewing during the event. Specific time will be dedicated to poster viewing following the luncheon. Presenters are not required to attend the entire event but will need to register for the summit. See Registration section for additional information.
- Posters may be taken down at the conclusion of the event on December 4.
- Hanging and removal of the posters are the responsibility of the poster presenter.

There is no fee to participate in this poster exhibition. Please reserve a space on-line through the event website by December 2, 2009. Poster exhibitors receive one (1) free conference registration (a pass code will be provided by IHIF upon confirmation of poster registration).
